

A8 Household expenses on consumption

Explanation For A-B, if the respondent answers in term of per month, divide the answer by 4.3 and then record the answer in Table.

If the expenses of 2 items cannot be separated, record the codes of both items in the "not separatable" column and specify the values of 2 items equally.

Example: Expenses on alcohol and cigarettes are 2000 baht per month, record as follows
