

A8 Household expenses on consumption

Explanation For A-B, in case the respondent answers in term of per month, divide the answer by 4.3 and then record the answer in the Table.

In case the cost of 2 items cannot be separated, record the codes of both items in the "not separatable" column and specify the values of 2 items equally.

Example: Expenses on alcohol and cigarettes are 2000 Baht per month, record as follows:

HC3: How much does the household receive these items? (In case of not receiving, record "0") Excluding consumption of product/goods in business and livestock sections
